

New Construction Project in Ostercappeln-Venne in the starting blocks

Häcker Küchen: Groundbreaking ceremony marks start of construction from the new factory

September 2018. It is the largest investment project in the company's history: Häcker Küchen GmbH is building another plant for production of high-quality kitchen furniture in Ostercappeln-Venne close to Osnabrück. The new building that will be erected in the immediate vicinity of headquarters in Rödinghausen, is one of the most modern plants to date. Several hundred qualified jobs are created and Häcker Küchen is gradually filling them. The groundbreaking ceremony now signalled the official start of construction.

Häcker Küchen has a reputation of a specialist for the production of high-quality kitchen furniture. The positive business development has always spoken for itself. The new building takes account of the envisaged growth and the associated increase in capacity, in order to map the Germany business location.

Häcker Küchen is implementing a future-oriented production and logistics concept on those 215,000 square meters of company premises in order to achieve the envisaged sales growth over the next few years.

In 2017 alone, the manufacturer of kitchen furniture generated a turnover of 553 million euros, with an export share currently accounting for around 40 percent - and the trend is upwards.

“The new building in Ostercappeln-Venne gives us the opportunity to set up state-of-the-art production flows based on digitised processes. A high level of automation will set standards in terms of process quality and productivity”, says Dirk Krupka, Managing Director of Technology at Häcker Küchen. “In this way, we can secure and expand our competitiveness in the long term. About 450 sustainable jobs will be created, which we are already filling. We are looking for employees in the production and internal logistic processes, machine operators, truck drivers and dispatchers, etc. Commissioning of the new plant is scheduled for autumn 2020.”

More than half of the suppliers from kitchen furniture manufacturer are located within a radius of less than 50

kilometres. The new location thus guarantees perfect integration of existing supplier structures, while at the same time creating the necessary logistical conditions such as storage capacities and material flow to ensure future growth also from a supply perspective.

“One of Häcker Küchen's main strategies is “Made in Germany” and will continue to secure jobs here in the region”, Jochen Finkemeier, Owner and Managing Director of Häcker Küchen explains.

The second extension of the Panorama administration building at Häcker Küchens' headquarters in Rödinghausen was completed in the summer of this year. The building complex with a total area of about 7,500 square metres, extends over four floors. On a total of 3,800 square metres exhibition space, Häcker has established an unparalleled presentation landscape. Daylight-flooded office floors on three levels accommodate around 300 work stations. And the brand-new and ultra-modern training centre, the “Häcker Campus”, also boasts a good 1,000 square metres of space.



“It is our responsibility to operate sustainably with what already exists. At the same time, the foundations for further growth must be laid. Our investments and projects are the testimony to our commitment”, says Jochen Finkemeier.

Häcker Küchen, an owner-managed family business has existed since 1898 and has been producing modern fitted kitchens at the Rödinghausen location in East Westphalia, the centre of the German kitchen furniture industry, since 1965.
